

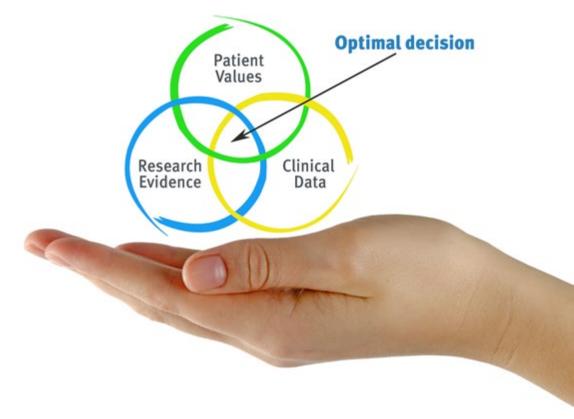


# tech 18 | Methodology


