# Introduction

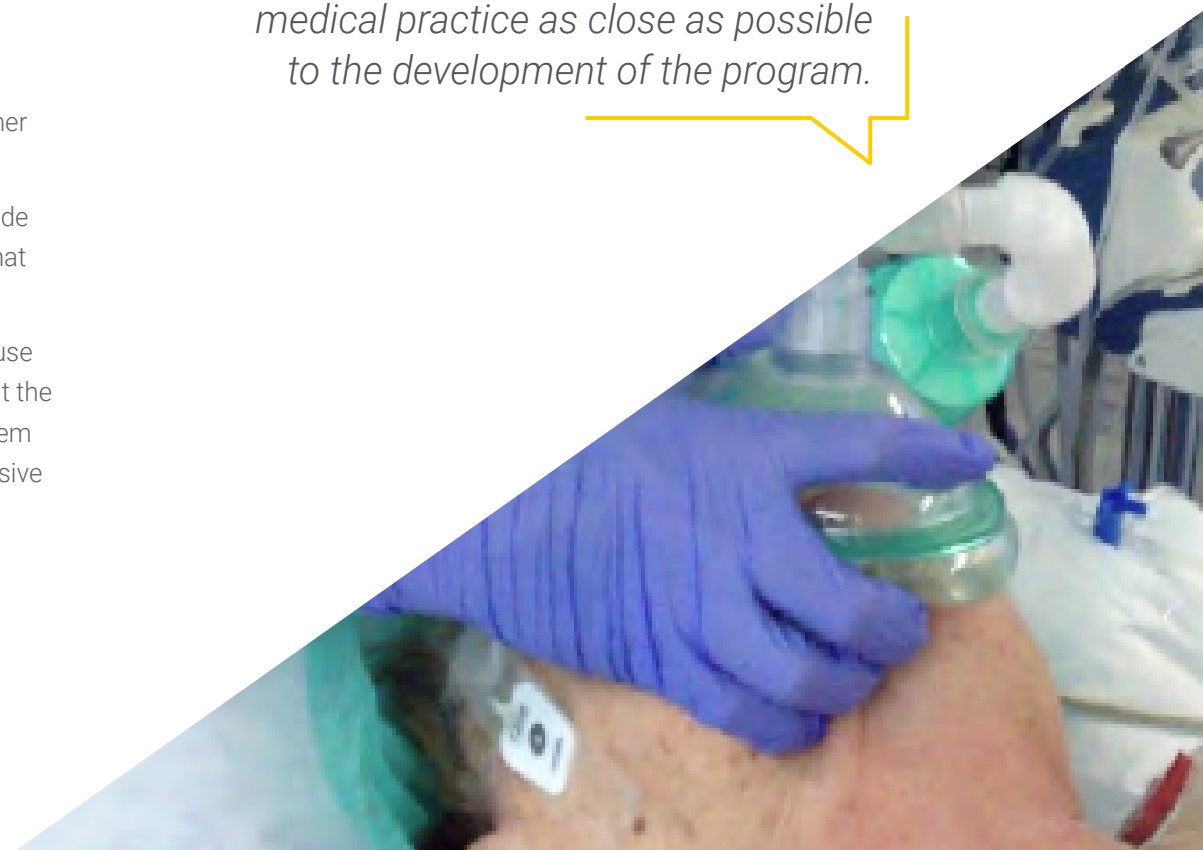

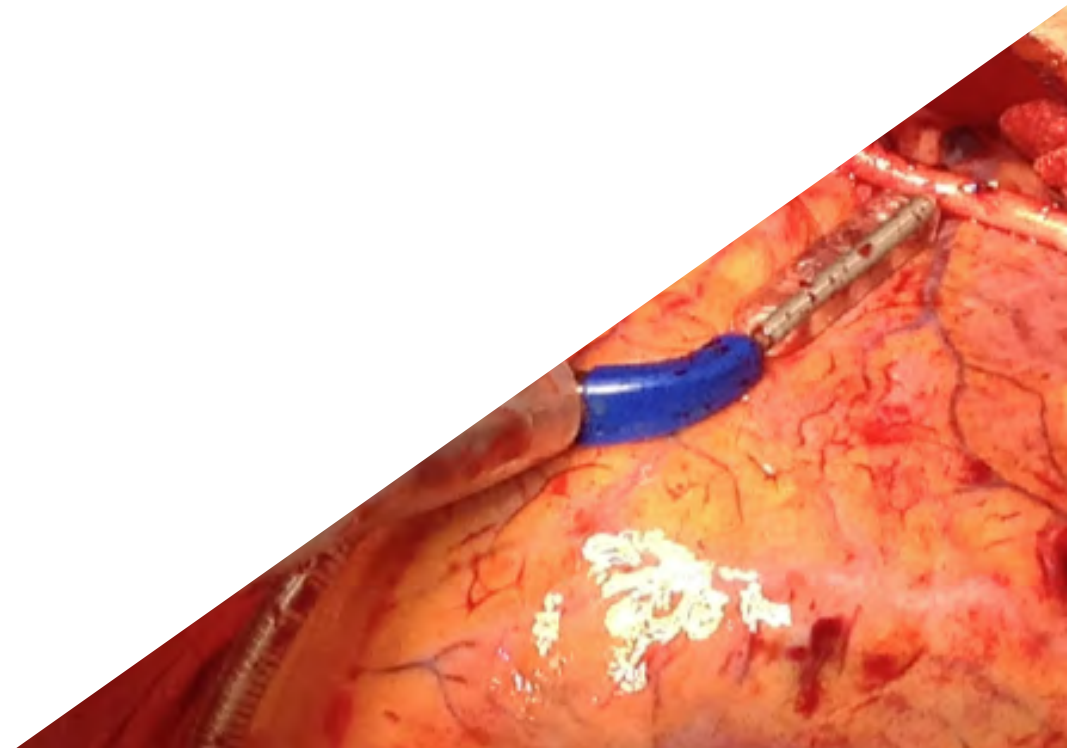

# Methodology
