

### tech 06 | Introduction

Understanding the pathophysiology of acne is key to being able to prescribe the appropriate treatment for each individual patient, given the clinical polymorphism of this disease. Each medication will act on one or more of the pathogenic pillars of acne and, depending on the predominance of retentional or inflammatory lesions, will be more or less effective.

The role of germs such as Propionibacterium acnes has also been gaining importance. In addition to the role of the infection itself, this germ has the ability to form a biofilm, thereby increasing its virulence and facilitating the development of bacterial resistance.

Environmental pollution, oxidative stress and the effect of the screens of our devices on the skin, is becoming increasingly important, and is the target of development of new cosmetic and therapeutic products.

We will also review those syndromes in which acne is one of the manifestations, in order to make a complete diagnosis and treatment in these patients.

The relationship between acne and diet is a question that patients constantly ask us about. The information that dermatologists have been providing to the population over the last decades has been changing radically, according to the scientific evidence generated by increasingly reliable studies. In any case, a series of myths and beliefs persist in the population that we must explain and correct, and for this we must be updated.

Acne, in addition, due to its pathogenesis, is related to obesity and overweight, as well as to metabolic syndrome and insulin resistance. In these cases, making good dietary and nutritional recommendations will increase the probabilities of therapeutic success.

A very promising field of research in acne, as in other chronic inflammatory diseases, is the study of the microbiota and the use of probiotics in its treatment.

In the clinic we encounter situations where acne treatment must be individualized and tailored to these specific circumstances.

It is not uncommon for pregnant women to have a worsening of their acne secondary to hormonal changes due to the pregnancy itself.




