



Gastrointestinal bleeding is defined as any blood loss originating in any segment of the gastrointestinal tract, and is considered a frequent cause of hospitalization, morbidity and mortality, particularly in elderly patients in whom this complication is more commonly found.

Bleeding can occur at any location in the gastrointestinal tract. In general, any bleeding originating from a location proximal to the ligament of Treitz is considered upper GI bleeding, and bleeding distal to the ligament is considered lower GI bleeding.

The intensity of the bleeding can range from massive to occult, so the role of the nursing staff in the care of patients with this pathology is very broad and can vary according to the different areas of approach.

The education of nurses on gastrointestinal bleeding is fundamental to achieve a comprehensive approach. However, at present, in the field of digestive nursing, there are no reference educational programs that go beyond small seminars, courses of a few hours or clinical sessions, and of all of them, many focus on the medical part, forgetting the metaparadigm of nursing, care.



In 1924, Harvard adopted it as a standard teaching method"

The effectiveness of the method is justified by four fundamental achievements:

- 1. Nurses who follow this method not only grasp concepts, but also develop their mental capacity, by evaluating real situations and applying their knowledge.
- 2. The learning process has a clear focus on practical skills that allow the nursing professional to better integrate knowledge acquisition into the hospital setting or primary care.
- 3. Ideas and concepts are understood more efficiently, given that the example situations are based on real-life.
- Students like to feel that the effort they put into their studies is worthwhile. This then translates into a greater interest in learning and more time dedicated to working on the course.




