It is essential that the case is based on current professional life, trying to recreate the real conditions of professional physiotherapy practice.

Did you know that this method was developed in 1912, at Harvard, for law students? The case method consisted of presenting students with real-life, complex situations for them to make decisions and justify their decisions on how to solve them. In 1924, Harvard adopted it as a standard teaching method"

The effectiveness of the method is justified by four fundamental achievements:

1. Physiotherapists/kinesiologists who follow this method not only grasp concepts, but also develop their mental capacity, by evaluating real situations and applying their knowledge.

2. The learning process has a clear focus on practical skills that allow the physiotherapist/kinesiologist to better integrate into the real world.

3. Ideas and concepts are understood more efficiently, given that the example situations are based on real-life.



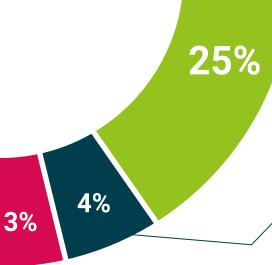
