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tech 6 | Introduction

An important trend in current psychopathological research is the description of Personality Disorders in terms that allow for a reliable differential diagnosis. The term schizophrenia was introduced by Bleuler in 1911, who considered it more appropriate to emphasize the splitting that occurs in the association of ideas, emotions and contact with reality and social life. Today schizophrenia is still one of the greatest challenges of science, affecting, as is well known, about 1% of the population.

Moreover, as it is an episodic disease that often returns after the acute episode to previous levels of normal functioning, the immediate consequence is that the individual between episodes tends to work, marry and have children in spite of their disease, because given the absence of symptoms, they are in a position to do so. Therefore, it is likely that the patient is often a spouse and/or parent in their family, rather than a single adult as is often the case in schizophrenia. Thus, the effects of the episode will be very relevant for the family, both psychologically and materially (loss of job and economic security).
