

What are the B1 Level Skills?

Level B1 is part of the Independent User Level, which is divided into two sublevels: First and Second Independent User Level (B1 and B2). Level B1 has two main features: the first is the ability to maintain interaction and to make oneself understood in a variety of situations.

The second characteristic is the ability to know how to deal flexibly with everyday problems. Most of the descriptors that are used in social functions are found at this level, such as, for example:



Can understand the main points of clear, standard-language texts on familiar matters, whether in work, study or leisure situations



Knows how to deal with most of the situations that may arise during a trip in areas where the language is used



- Find and understand relevant information in everyday written material, such as letters, catalogs, and short official documents.
- Consult long texts in order to find the desired information, and to know how to gather information from different parts of a text or from different texts in order to perform a specific task.
- Recognize significant ideas from simple newspaper articles that deal with everyday issues
- Identify the main conclusions in clearly argumentative texts. Recognize the line of argument in the treatment of the issue presented, though not necessarily in full detail

- Adapt expression to deal with less common and even difficult situations. Use a wide range
 of simple linguistic elements with the flexibility to express much of what is wanted
- Participate in debates on everyday topics using an appropriate phrase to take the floor.
 Initiate, maintain, and conclude simple face-to-face conversations on everyday topics or topics of personal interest
- Give simple narratives or descriptions, with a reasonable degree of fluency, through a linear sequence of elements
- Linking a series of short, specific and simple elements to create a cohesive, linear sequence

Linguistic Competence

- Possess sufficient linguistic ability to describe unpredictable situations, to explain the main points of an idea or problem with reasonable accuracy, and to express thoughts on abstract or cultural topics, such as music and movies..
- Possess sufficient linguistic ability to get by, and sufficient vocabulary to express themselves
 with some hesitation and circumlocution on topics such as family, hobbies and interests,
 work, travel and current events, but lexical limitations lead to repetition and sometimes even
 difficulties in formulation.
- Possess sufficient vocabulary to express themselves with some circumlocution on most topics relevant to their daily lives, such as family, hobbies and interests, work, travel, and current events.
- Demonstrate a good command of elementary vocabulary, even if significant errors are made when expressing more complex thoughts, or when dealing with unusual topics and situations.
- Communicate with reasonable accuracy in everyday situations; generally have good grammatical control, although with obvious mother tongue influence
- Use, with reasonable accuracy, a repertoire of common "formulas" and structures related to the most predictable situations.
- Speak clearly and intelligibly, even if the foreign accent is sometimes evident and occasional mispronunciations are made.
- Produce continuous writing that is usually intelligible throughout. Spelling, punctuation and structuring are correct enough to be understood most of the time.



Did you know?

Communicative competence is not merely limited to the knowledge and ability to use the linguistic code, but has other broader dimensions, which place it in direct relation with other competences such as information processing and digital competence, learning to learn, social and civic competence, or cultural and artistic competence.

This implies a cultural immersion that is only possible to recreate in the online format through simulated scenarios, *storytelling*, videos and real situations.
