03 What Is Level C1?

Level C1 is part of the Proficient User Level, which is further divided into two sub-levels: First and Second Proficient User Levels (C1 and C2).

Level C1 is called Effective Operational Proficiency. What seems to characterize this level is good access to a broad linguistic repertoire. This allows for fluid and spontaneous communication, as illustrated in the following examples: express themselves fluently and spontaneously, almost effortlessly. Good command of an extensive lexical repertoire that allows them to easily overcome their deficiencies with circumlocutions. There is hardly any noticeable search for expressions or avoidance strategies; only a conceptually difficult topic can hinder the natural flow of their speech.

The discourse skills that characterize the previous band are still evident at Level C1, with an emphasis on greater fluency; for example: is able to select, from a fluid repertoire of discourse functions, the most appropriate phrase with which to begin comments in order to take the floor or to gain time and hold it while thinking; produces clear, fluent and wellstructured speech; and has control of organizational structures, connectors and cohesive mechanisms.




Years of unsuccessful attempts to learn the language


