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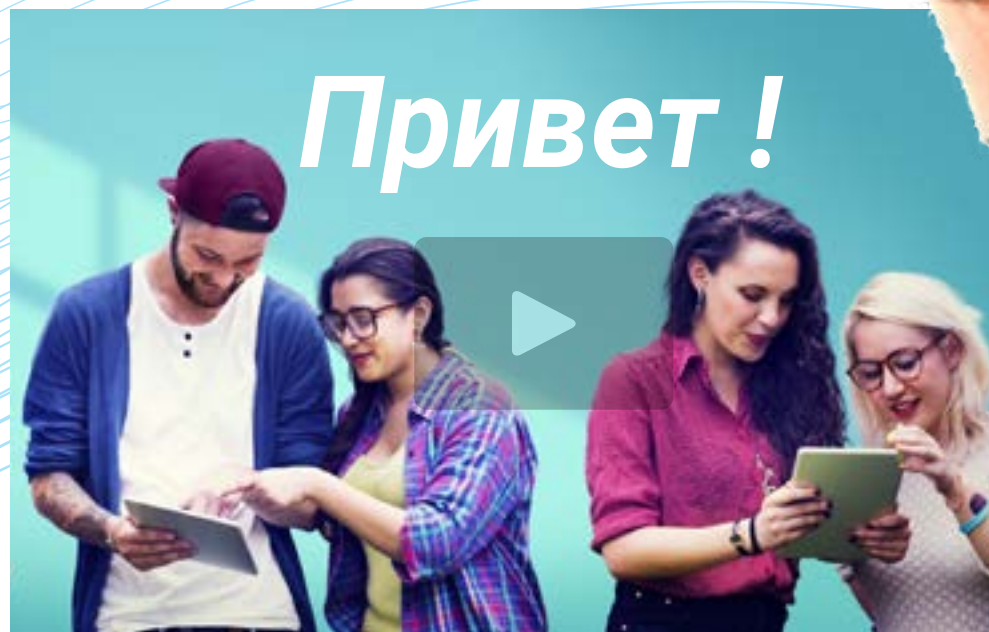

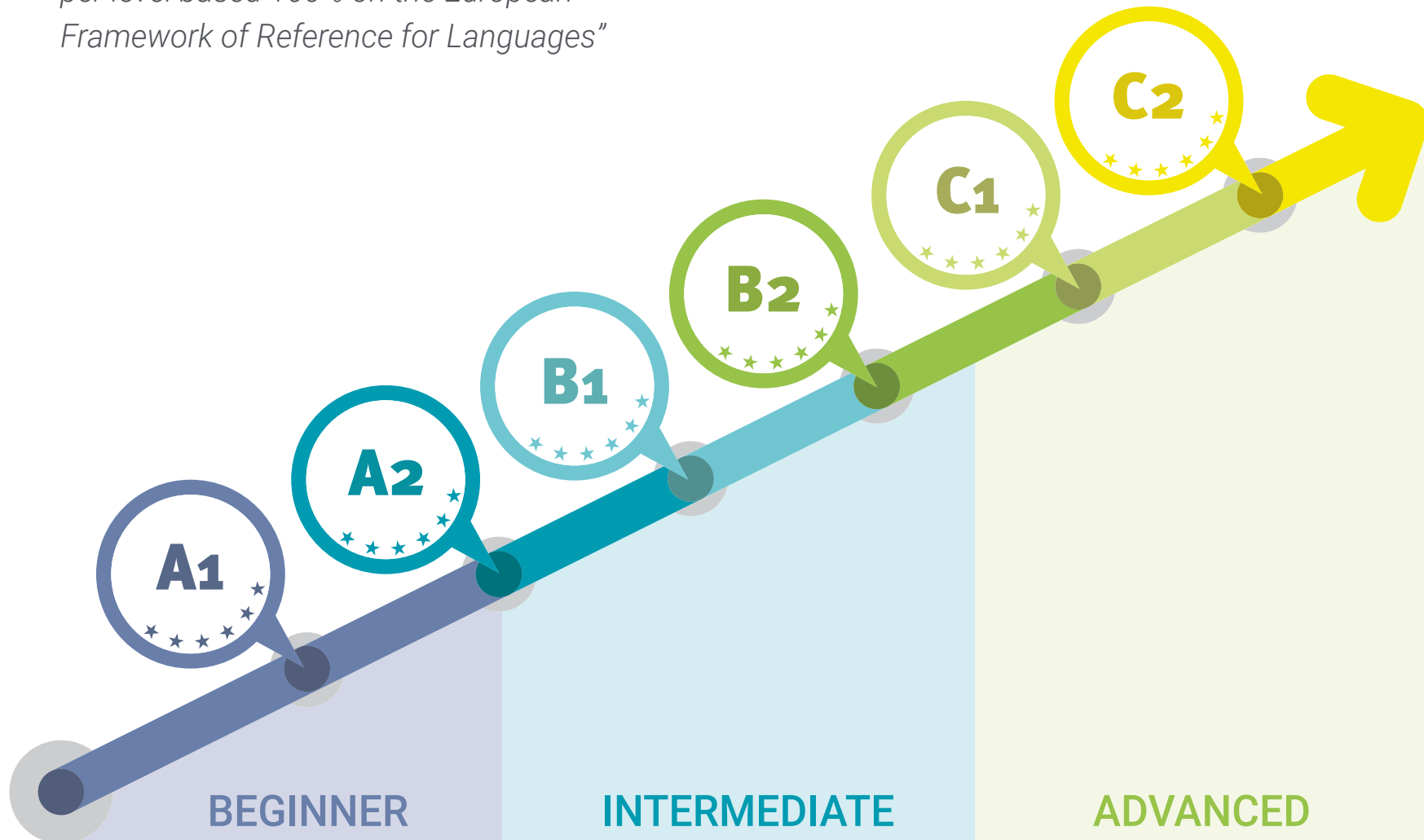

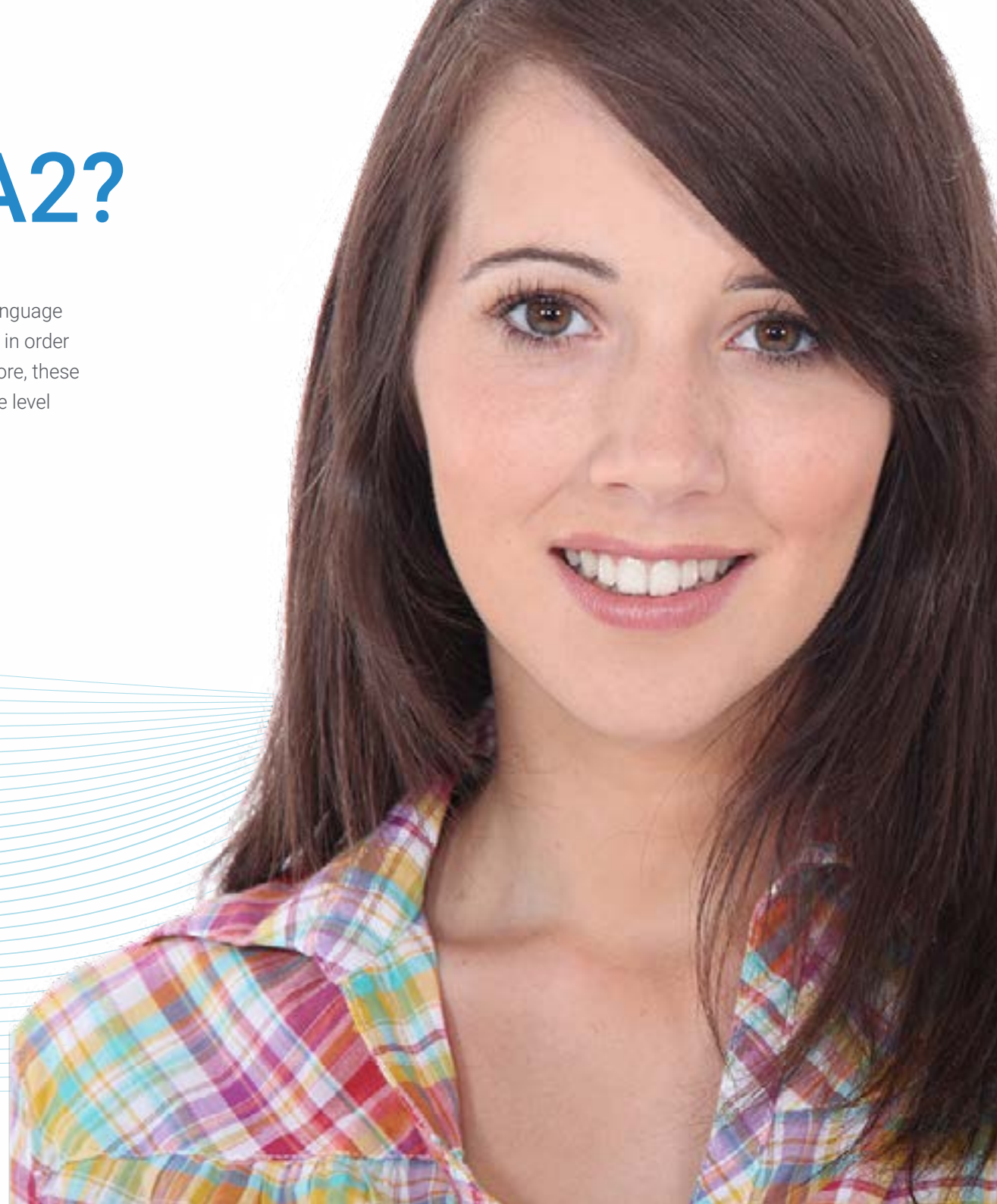

What Is Level A2?

One of the purposes of the CEFR is to help users describe the levels of language proficiency required by existing examinations and assessment programs in order to facilitate comparisons between different certification systems. Therefore, these levels are a universal scale used to unify and clarify the different language level evaluation systems.

What are the A2 Level Skills?

Level A2 is part of basic User Level, which is divided into two sublevels: first and Second Basic User Level (A1 and A2). Most of the descriptors that are used in social functions are found at this level, such as, for example:

01

Can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of experience that are particularly relevant to him/her (basic information about him/herself and his/her family, shopping, places of interest, occupations, etc.)

What is expected to be achieved with this level?

Scope

- ◆ Use structures composed of basic sentences with expressions, groups of a few words and memorized formulas, in order to communicate limited information in simple, everyday situations

Correction

- ◆ Use some simple structures correctly, although basic systematic mistakes are still made

Fluency

- ◆ Make oneself understood with very brief expressions, although pauses, initial doubts and rephrasing very evident

Interaction

- ◆ Answer questions and respond to simple statements
- ◆ Indicate when they understand a conversation, but barely understand enough to carry on a conversation on their own accord

Coherence

- ◆ Linking groups of words with simple connectors such as "and", "but" and "because"

Oral Comprehension

- ◆ Understand enough to be able to deal with specific needs as long as the speech is articulated clearly and at a slow pace
- ◆ Understand sentences and expressions related to areas of immediate priority (e.g., very basic personal and family information, shopping, place of residence, employment) provided speech is articulated clearly and slowly
- ◆ Generally identify the topic being discussed, provided it is conducted slowly and clearly
- ◆ Capture the main idea of short, clear and simple messages and statements
- ◆ Understand simple instructions on how to get from one place to another, both on foot and by public transportation
- ◆ Understand and extract essential information from short recorded passages dealing with everyday, predictable matters and spoken slowly and clearly



Reading Comprehension

- ◆ Understand short, simple texts on everyday matters if they contain very frequent, everyday or work-related vocabulary
- ◆ Understand short and simple texts containing very frequent vocabulary, including a good part of internationally shared vocabulary terms
- ◆ Understand basic types of commonly used letters and faxes (forms, orders, confirmation letters, etc.) on everyday topics
- ◆ Understand short and simple personal letters
- ◆ Find specific and predictable information in everyday written material, such as advertisements, prospectuses, restaurant menus or menus, listings, and schedules
- ◆ Locate specific information in listings and isolate the required information (e.g., knows how to use the "Yellow Pages" to search for a service or a business)
- ◆ Understand signs and signals found in public places, such as streets, restaurants, train stations, and workplaces, e.g., directions to a location, instructions, and hazard warnings

- ◆ Identify specific information in simple written material, such as letters, catalogs, and short newspaper articles describing specific events
- ◆ Understand rules that are expressed at a simple level of language.
- ◆ Understand simple instructions for frequently used appliances, such as a public telephone
- ◆ Identify the main idea of television news reporting events, accidents, etc., when there is visual support to complement the discourse
- ◆ Know when TV news has changed topics and get an idea of the main content



Written Expression

- ◆ Write a series of simple phrases and sentences linked with simple connectors such as "and", "but" and "because"

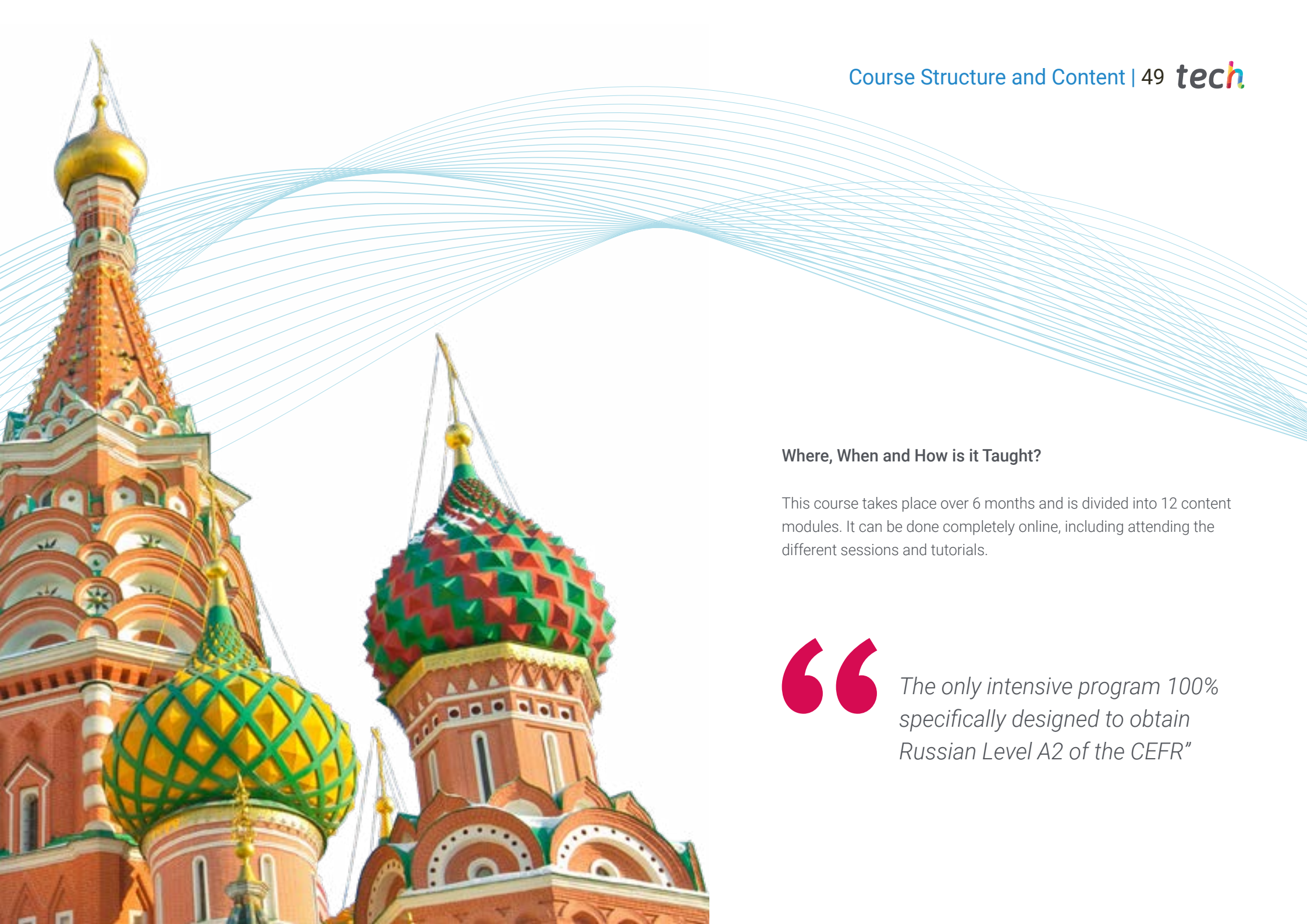

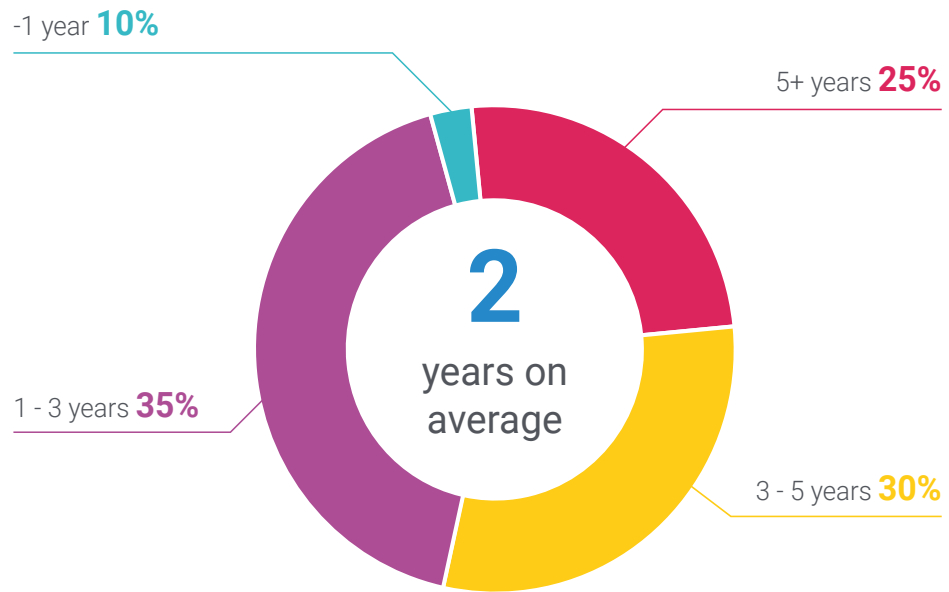




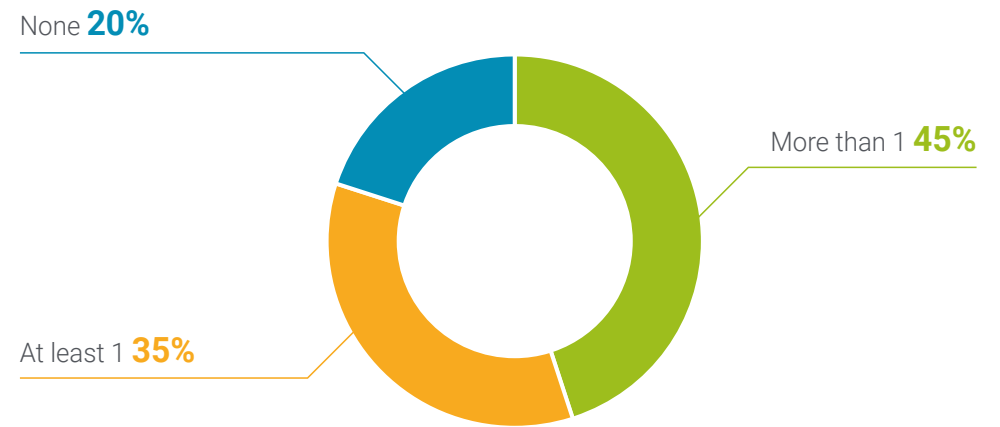

The Professional Benefits of Russian

Russian is becoming increasingly international. More and more people are communicating in the language of Tolstoy and Dostoevsky, and it is not surprising that Russian has a place among the world's most widely spoken languages. In fact, the language of the Czars is taught in about a hundred countries. This boost stems not only from cultural reasons, but also from economic interests that in recent years have led to an increase in the number of people learning the Cyrillic alphabet.

It has official status in Russia, Belarus, Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan, while in the other republics of the former USSR it is used as a second language. Between native speakers and those who speak it as a second language, it is spoken daily by 260 million people.

Russian is one of the most widely used languages on the Internet. According to some statistics (and depending on when the data is taken) it is the second most used language on the Internet only behind English. 6% of all web pages in the world are in Russian. For example, only 3.3% of the Internet is in Chinese and its population is 9 times that of Russia. Russia is the sixth largest Internet user in the world. Another interesting fact about Russian is that 25% of the world's scientific literature is published in this language.

Russian has become one of the few official languages used in major world institutions. It is an official language of the UN, the OSCE (Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe) and the SCO (Shanghai Cooperation Organization).

Russia is one of the world's largest exporters of natural gas, oil and diamonds. It is also a world leader in space, aeronautics and weapons technology. Russia is the world's largest country, which makes it a world leader in various natural resources. It is also a source of intellectual, cultural and economic knowledge. All this makes Russian an important language in different sectors.




